The psychological problems of ex-military personnel are currently of heightened political, media and therapeutic interest and are often understood within the framework of a diagnosis of Post Traumatic Stress Disorder, for which the recommended treatment (NICE Guideline 2005) is trauma-focused Cognitive Behaviour Therapy or Eye Movement Desensitisation and Reprocessing.

This year's Trauma Seminar offers a space to explore the complexity of ex-service personnel's mental health issues from a psychoanalytic perspective, looking at individual variability and the idea that many presentations can only be understood and managed by exploring the childhood origins of adult difficulties.

Whatever their preferred model of working, therapists are likely to encounter similar struggles around engagement, how to understand ex-military personnel's difficulties, drug and alcohol abuse and how to be of help.

We hope that this afternoon will be of interest to clinicians working within psychoanalytic, cognitive behavioural and other models. It will include an overview of recent government initiatives relating to the provision of services for ex-service men and women and detailed clinical examples from the Tavistock Trauma Service. Small group discussion will allow space to reflect on one's own work within this perspective.
